Help Living Waters Church and School in Tradition with big Easter Project.

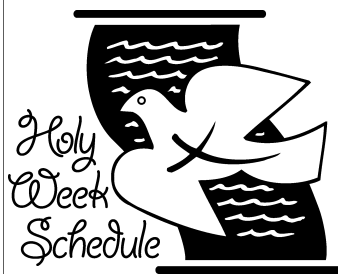
