Feature this week

“The Cost of Discipleship” was written by a young Lutheran pastor named Dietrich Bonhoeffer, who joined the underground resistance in World War II, convinced that it was his duty to work towards Hitler’s defeat. He was only 39 when he died, but he had already made a monumental contribution to Christian thought, which had a profound significance for both theologian and layman. He writes: “Cheap grace is the grace we bestow on ourselves...the preaching of forgiveness without requiring repentance, baptism without church discipline, communion without confession.”

He also writes: “Costly grace is the gospel which must be sought again and again, the gift which must be asked for, the door at which man must knock.”

The London Times Literary said of the book: “A rigorously patient exposition of the Sermon which compels the reader to face himself... A very moving book.”

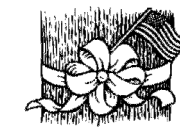
