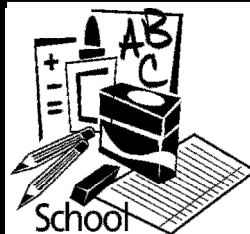
Our condolences to Richard and Rose Knox who lost their daughter, Karen Thomas, to cancer. We ask God to bless their entire family at this difficult time.
