Immanuel's Christian Library Feature of The Week!

"It's Your Death...Make the Most of It" by Harold Billnitzer, is a book that will challenge you to look seriously at the whole "business" of death ... to deal with "questions that aren't being answered and answers that aren't being questioned." There are many books about death ... but, none more practical and honest!

The author is a Lutheran minister who retired from his parish ministry because of Multiple Sclerosis and resides in a nursing home in Ohio. Pastor Billnitzer has continued his ministry to fellow MS patients and others by telephone and tape-recorder. In 1976 he testified before the Bureau of Consumer Protection and the Federal Trade Commission about American funeral practices. In 1979 the National Multiple Sclerosis Society published his life story, "I Have Fought the Good Fight—But, I'm not Finished."

Pastor Billnitzer is a dynamic, inspiring and honest man that can help all of us rise above our fears.
